Sermon Title: "Resurrection Stories: Whom Do You Seek?" Sermon Text: John 20:1-18

1. Truths I'm Affirming

Seek after Jesus (John 20:1-8).

- Seek Jesus in the darkness In the face of our fear, grief, anger, and doubt, we must seek Jesus.
- Seek Jesus together.

Seek Jesus and believe (John 20:8-10, 31).

• In our pursuit of Jesus, what makes Him worth seeking is that He indeed is alive!

Seek after Jesus and He will find you (John 20:11-18).

- You only find life in Jesus the only one who overcame sin and death.
- Death did not steal Him, darkness could not hide Him, and nothing can keep Him from His children.

2. Questions I'm Asking

Has fear ever kept me from seeking Jesus and away from God's people? What about grief, anger, or doubt?

What things in my life am I often tempted to seek after, rather than pursue Jesus?

When is the last time I intentionally reflected on what Jesus has done in my life and the promises He has made to His children? What are some practical steps I can take to reflect on those things more regularly?

3. Actions I'm Taking

- Refuse to let the darkness of life keep me from seeking Jesus together with God's people.
- Remind myself daily to protect my heart and the heart of my family and friends from seeking peace, hope, and life in all the wrong places.
- Write down some of the things Jesus has done in my life, reflect on them daily, and share them with my family and missional community.
- Make time throughout the week to read Scripture, pray, and sing worship songs with my family.
